

How to Apply

All applications to the Foundation Degree in Circus Arts are dealt with directly by the Degree Admissions Service at The Circus Space. Applicants wishing to receive a form through the mail should contact the Degree Admissions Service by:

Once we have received your application form you will be invited to one of the three auditions being held throughout the year. **Applications for the Foundation Degree Course beginning in September 2008 will be accepted until the 31st of May 2008.**

Auditions dates are as follows:

- 7th and 8th April 2008
- 14th and 15th April 2008
- 2nd and 3rd June 2008
- 5th and 6th June 2008

Please note: Auditions are by Invitation only.

Auditions for entry to the Foundation Degree in Circus Arts are held over a two-day period. On the first day candidates will partake in theatre, movement, acrobatic and juggling workshops. A strength and flexibility assessment is also made during that day. On the second day, candidates present a 3-minute piece of their own devising. Some candidates may be asked to stay for a brief interview, this would be to clarify information only and is not part of the audition process. 2008/2009 Academic Year School Fees

The annual fee for new EU and UK students starting the Conservatoire of Dance and Drama (CDD) undergraduate courses in September 2008 is £3145. The annual fee for new Overseas students is £13,340.

UK students can apply for a tuition fee loan, maintenance loan and maintenance grant at the same time and forms are available from your local authority, or online www.aimhigher.ac.uk

Don't wait until you've been offered a place on your course. You can start to apply in the March before you start your course and the sooner the better, as demand is high.
